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SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Eligibility

- Must operate a commercial or institutional facility within the City of Santa Clara
- Must meet the BOC training <u>requirements</u>

BOC Training Requirements:

- Level I: Building Systems Maintenance, one of the following:
 - Two or more years of experience working in operations and maintenance of a commercial or institutional facility
 - A minimum of one year of experience working in operations and maintenance of a commercial or institutional facility AND one year of technical college level education in facilities engineering related program
 - Two or more years of experience in energy management in facilities with a focus on operations and maintenance
- Level II: Equipment Troubleshooting and Maintenance, one of the following:
 - A technical degree and three years of experience working in operations and maintenance of a commercial or institutional facility
 - A union membership at journey level and three years of experience
 - o BOC Level I Training Certificate of Completion or Certification and four years of experience

Submitting for Reimbursement:

Upon completion of the program, submit proof of payment and a copy of your Training Certificate of Completion (TCOC) within 60 days of course completion. If you choose to take the certification exam, exam fees will also be reimbursed for successfully passing the exam. No reimbursement will be provided for a non-passing score. A copy of the Building Operator Certification with passing exam score must be provided within 60 days of completing the course series to be considered for reimbursement under the scholarship program.
